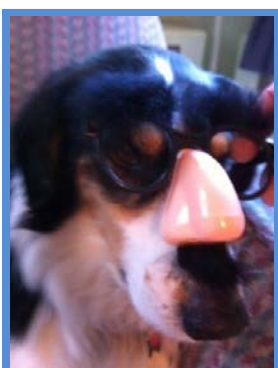
KNOCK, KNOCK. *Who's there?* Snow. *Snow who?* Snow use. I forgot my name again!
