I find today’s letter of St. Paul to the Philippians hopeful, encouraging, consoling, and comforting. Pray it every day this week for yourself and for those you care for and are most concerned about.

*“Brothers and sisters: Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God. Then the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.*

*Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is gracious, if there is any excellence, and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. Keep on doing what you have learned and received and heard and seen in me. Then the God of peace will be with you.” (Philippians 4:6-9)*

Keep on keeping on, everyone. Rest assured you remain in my prayers. Let’s keep praying for each other. I am praying St. Paul’s words for all of you. “May the peace of God always guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus now and always. Amen, Alleluia!!!
